**Important Message from HCPT - It is with profound regret that we announce HCPT's 2020 Easter Pilgrimage to Lourdes has been cancelled.**

This decision was taken by HCPT's board of trustees, with the support of the management team, after a detailed evaluation of the situation surrounding the COVID 19 (coronavirus) epidemic, and consideration of likely trends over the next few months. The decision took particular account of announcements made yesterday by French authorities with regard to the risks of gathering in large numbers and also our concerns about the potential risk of any requirement for a period of isolation in France should an outbreak of the virus occur.
