**Guidance for Communal Worship during England's

From Tuesday, 5th January 2021, a lockdown has been
put in force for England to curb the transmission of
COVID-19. Catholic Churches in England can remain
open for communal worship such as the celebration of
Mass providing necessary steps are taken to keep people
safe. This means you must not mingle with anyone outside
of your household or support bubble. You should maintain
strict social distancing at all times. If you are in the
clinically extremely vulnerable group and have been
advised to shield, you should not attend church at this time.
Please do not attend if you or a member of your family feel
unwell with any symptoms at all, not just COVID. We are
following the national guidelines on the safe use of church
so we ask you to help us do this by following all instructions
when attending church. Thank you.
