Given the prevailing conditions, they have decided that it would not be right to reinstate the Sunday obligation to attend Mass at the present; however, they strongly urge us all to place the worship of God at the centre of Sunday, attending Mass where possible, but also trying to make sure that other activities do not draw us away from him. <https://www.cbcew.org.uk/bishops-statement-honouringsunday/>

**DIOCESAN COVID CONTROLS** Please be aware some COVID controls remain in place in our churches.

**Hand sanitiser** - use of hand sanitiser on entering and leaving church.

**Sign of Peace** will remain suspended.


