Bishop Robert's pastoral letter on the 4th Sunday of Easter, he wrote, "*On the Solemnity of Corpus Christi (19th June) we will have the opportunity to celebrate our Eucharistic faith publicly in a Blessed Sacrament procession. More details will follow but I hope this will be the highlight of the Eucharistic Year with many clergy and faithful taking part.*"

Ushaw has implemented a maximum capacity policy for people in the chapel and refectory, and parking spaces.
